IN THE NEIGHBOURHOOD:

1. Canada Life Building (330 University Ave.) Look west to see this Beaux Arts structure topped by a unique 1950's weather beacon. It reports temperature and weather conditions through a series of flashing coloured lights.

2. Four Seasons Centre for the Performing Arts (145 Queen St. W)
This iconic site is home to the Canadian Opera Company and The National Ballet of Canada. **Enjoy the views over University Avenue during the opening reception!**

3. Roy Thomson Hall (60 Simcoe St.)
Home to the Toronto Symphony Orchestra, this concert hall has a unique architecture. A popular spot for the Toronto International Film Festival, this famous venue also features Canada's Walk of Fame. Look for the stars!

4. Canadian Broadcasting Centre (250 Front St. W.)
Across the street from the MTCC's North Building you'll see a red, 12-story building. Home to Canada's national public broadcaster, inside you'll find the studios of some local shows.
