Bite into flaky, freshly caught Manitoba pickerel or sample the layered deliciousness of a traditional Icelandic treat.

From Gimli we head further north to Hecla Island. Here on the prairie, there's a place where stories of sunken ships and magical islands are told, where the water and fishing is a way of life. Hecla Island was named after one of the most famous landmarks in Iceland, the volcano Mount Hekla. Today, Hecla Island is the hub of activity in this year-round natural playground. Oak Hammock Marsh is our final stop on our return to Winnipeg. The tour will close with a private industry event at the Canadian Museum for Human Rights.

We will journey through Treaties 1 and 3 and gain knowledge and learn the teachings of the indigenous culture.

Lakeshores and boreal forests are the feature of this all season Canadian shield playground. From hiking to water activities and breathtaking views to historic sites, each region of Manitoba holds a secret worth discovering.
