FAM description: This tour is designed for you to explore New Brunswick's rich culture, unique history, coastal experiences and friendly people.

Located on Canada's Atlantic coast, this maritime province is an unspoiled, untapped, serene adventure mecca of Atlantic Canada. New Brunswick's southern coastline shoulders the phenomenal Bay of Fundy, home to the highest tides in the world, which rise and fall (48 ft. / 14 m) twice a day, an area compared only to the Amazon Rainforest in marine biodiversity.

Seaside fishing villages, charming resorts, and outposts rich in maritime tradition dot New Brunswick's Fundy coast. Key regions explored during this tour will include the city of Saint John, a seaport city located on the Bay of Fundy. The iconic seaside resort town of St. Andrews. Newly connected Fundy Trail Parkway hugging the coast and part of the UNESCO Fundy Biosphere Reserve. The charming village of St. Martins showcasing those unic sea cave. The Hopewell Rocks, the place where the power of the Bay of Fundy tides is most impressive. As well as Moncton, the hub of the Maritimes situated in great proximity to the two most diverse coastline in NB: the Bay of Fundy with its rocky cliffs and high tides, and the Acadian Coast with its white sand and warm beaches.

Please note:

While this adventure is not overly strenuous, participants must be of "fair" physical fitness. (e.g. must be able to walk on uneven terrain, endure outdoor conditions)
